

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Dear Parent / Carer

At the end of my first half term as Headteacher of Ysgol Llanhari, I would like to express my sincere gratitude to the school's staff and pupils for ensuring that this first half term has been a successful, busy term. It has been a pleasure to witness the pupils' positive engagement with school life. Thank you too to you as parents for your continued support.

The primary and secondary pupils have enjoyed various activities in class and also extra-curricular opportunities and I am grateful to the teachers for all they are offering to enrich the experiences of the pupils of Ysgol Llanhari. As you are aware, the primary department and year 7 are following the New Curriculum for Wales and this has resulted in a new range of experiences for your children. Our vision for the curriculum can be seen on the school's website.

It was a pleasure to welcome some of you as parents to the school during the half term. Although the progress evenings continue on *Schoolcloud*, we will organize evenings for parents of every school year to visit us at a certain period during the year. The next event will be held for parents of the primary department and year 7 on Wednesday 9th of November. This is an opportunity to learn more about our curriculum.

We wish our year 11 pupils well. They will be sitting GCSE Welsh Language exams during the first two weeks after half term. Before the end of the two weeks, a Sixth form Taster Day will be held where year 11 pupils will have the opportunity to spend a day as year 12 pupils enjoying a taste of lessons and also learning about life in the sixth form in Llanhari.

This week, a special day was held to remember Gwenllian Pugh, our former pupil who passed away in September. The activities were organized by year 12 pupils and they succeeded in collecting over £1000 towards the *To Wish Upon a Star* charity. Thank you all for your generous contributions. We are also very grateful to the parents of the primary department for your donations to the local food bank. The goods were handed over by Miss Rowlands and the Ambassadors this week - 187 kilos in all!

We have been revising our positive behaviour policy during this half term in the secondary department and the pupils' response has been fantastic. We will also trial the modifications to the policy in the primary department after half term. I am very grateful to Mr Marc Evans, Acting Deputy Headteacher for leading on this and consequently this policy has had a positive effect on the pupils' attitude to learning during the half term. We will be adapting our use of Classcharts in the secondary department during the next half term and changing where necessary, before introducing more aspects of it in the primary department.

Many thanks to Ffrindiau Llanhari for organizing a successful Halloween event on the last Thursday night of the term and to members of the sixth form for their help with the activities. The next meeting of Ffrindiau Llanhari will be on Thursday the 10th of November at 5 o'clock in the school. New members are welcome. The next event will be a disco for years 7 and 8 on the 1st of December. Finally, I would like to draw your attention to the latest news regarding the Covid regulations from the Welsh Government.

The government has confirmed that the public and children do not need to be tested for Covid even if they are ill.
