Dear Parents / Carers

I am writing to you to ask you for your assistance in ensuring that all the secondary department's pupils adhere to our high standards with regards to their school uniform. Many pupils wear the correct school uniform and look neat and tidy but during the past half term, standards have slipped and many more pupils challenge the school rules regarding the correct school uniform. Consequently, the standard of the school uniform has deteriorated. **This is unacceptable and does not reflect our high standards as a school.**

An increasing number of girls have been wearing leggings and short skirts and boys have been wearing tracksuit bottoms and trainers. Boys and girls have started wearing hoodies with logos and not school hoodies. **These items of clothing are not our school uniform.**

The pupils are all well aware of the correct uniform and after half term we will be providing uniform from our second-hand stock to pupils who do not conform to our rules. We will inform you straight away through Classcharts. I trust that you will co-operate with us and ensure that pupils return to school after half term on the 27<sup>th</sup> of February in the correct school uniform. I'm grateful to you in advance for your co-operation and support as parents as you re-iterate our expectations with your child during the coming holidays. If you have any questions, please contact your child's Progress Leader.

**Please see a summary of the correct school uniform below:**

**The following items are compulsory for boys and girls:**

- School hoodie with school badge
- School polo shirt (T shirts are not to be worn under the polo shirt)
- Plain sturdy black shoes
- Trainers are not allowed
- Dark coat or jacket

**Girls' Uniform**

- Plain black knee length skirt or plain black trousers in a style 'suitable for the workplace', below the ankle. No short lycra skirts.
- **Tight trousers, leggings, tracksuits and jeans are not allowed**
- Black or white socks or black tights
- No make-up or jewellery is allowed apart from ear studs.
- Hairstyle and colour is expected to be natural and suitable for the workplace.
